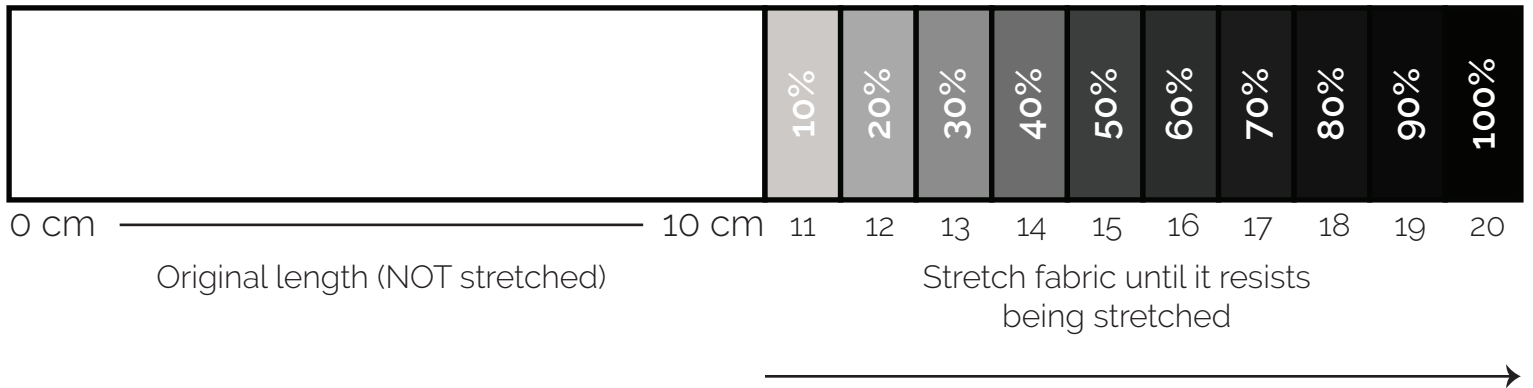


Genuinely Em **Stretch Test Ruler**



How to Use the Ruler

1. Hold your fabric with your left hand at the 0 cm mark and hold the fabric with your right hand at the 10 cm mark. DO NOT stretch the fabric. Simply measure 10 cm of fabric.
2. Keep your left hand at the 0 cm mark and stretch the fabric with your right hand until you feel resistance.
3. The amount that it stretches over the 10 cm mark will tell you its stretch %.

Equation

$$\frac{\text{Amount stretched past 10 cm mark}}{10 \text{ cm}} \times 100 = \text{Fabric Stretch \%}$$

Example: If fabric measured 12 cm when stretched...

$$\frac{2 \text{ cm}}{10 \text{ cm}} \times 100 = 20\%$$
